What is sexual misconduct?

Sexual misconduct is an umbrella term covering sex discrimination, sexual harassment and sexual violence.

What is sexual discrimination?

It's a serious offense and it includes discrimination on the basis of pregnancy, gender identity and failure to conform to stereotypical notions of femininity and masculinity.

What is sexual harassment?

It's an attempt to coerce an unwilling person into a sexual relationship or to subject them to an unwanted sexual relationship, whatever form it may take.

What is sexual violence?

It is a physical sexual act perpetrated against a person's will or consent.
