PURPOSE: This policy defines the organizational structure of the college's academic units by identifying the divisions, departments, and degree programs through which instructional programs are administered. It clarifies how academic programs are aligned within departments and divisions to support consistent governance, oversight, and communication of the institution's academic offerings.

DEFINITION OF TERMS IN THIS POLICY:

1. **Division:** The departments are classified into four major divisions of instruction.
2. **Department:** The degree programs and faculty are organized within departments.
3. **Program:** The program curricula of Kettering College lead to associate of science (AS), bachelor of science (BS), bachelor of science in health sciences (BSHS), bachelor of science in nursing (BSN), masters or doctoral degrees.

POLICY DETAILS:

The college's divisions, departments, and degree programs (in parentheses below) are as follows:

The Division of Arts & Sciences includes the following academic departments:

- Humanities and Social Sciences (Minor in Spiritual Care)
- Science and Mathematics

The Division of Health Professions includes the following academic departments:

- Diagnostic Medical Sonography (BS – Major in Diagnostic Medical Sonography)
- Health Sciences (AS – Major in Health Sciences; BSHS – Major in Healthcare Management; BSHS – Major in Healthcare Studies)
- Radiologic Sciences and Imaging (AS – Radiologic Technology)
- Respiratory Care (BS – Major in Respiratory Care)

The Division of Nursing includes the following academic department:

- Nursing (BS in Nursing; MS in Nursing)

The Division of Graduate Studies includes the following academic departments:

- Occupational Therapy (Occupational Therapy Doctorate)
- Physician Assistant Studies (Master of Physician Assistant Studies)
